S.V. INSTITUTE OF MANAGEMENT (SVIM) – KADI, SCHEDULED CASTES/SCHEDULED TRIBE (SC/ST) CELL

Objectives and Goals of the SC/ST Cell

- To implement the reservation policy for SC/ST category candidates, in the College.
- To register the names of SC/ST students and prepare a list of students for guidance and support to avail the benefits provided by the State and Central Government.
- To work as the Grievances Redressal Cell for SC/ST category students.
- To take such follow up measures for achieving the objectives and targets laid down for the purpose by the State Government.
- To implement, monitor and evaluate continuously the reservations policy in the institute and plan measures for ensuring effective implementation of the policy and programmes of the State and Central Government.

Definition (For The Purpose of SC/ST Cell)

- 1. "Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes" shall have the meanings assigned to them respectively under clause (24) and clause (25) of article 366 of the Constitution
- 2. "atrocity" means an offence punishable under section 3;
- 3. "Code" means the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (2 of 1974)
- 4. Words and expressions unsed but not defined in this Act and defined in the Code or the Indian Penal Code (45 of 1860) shall have the meanings assigned to them respectively in the Code, or as the case may be, in the Indian Penal Code

Offence of Atrocities

Whoever, not being a member of a Scheduled Caste or a Scheduled Tribe

- forces a member of a Scheduled Caste or a Scheduled Tribe to drink or eat any inedible or obnoxious substance;
- acts with intent to cause injury, insult or annoyance to any member of a Scheduled Caste, or a Scheduled Tribe
- intentionally insults or intimidates with intent to humiliate a member of a Scheduled Caste or a Scheduled Tribe in any place within public view;
- assaults or uses force to any woman belonging to a Scheduled Caste or a Scheduled Tribe with intent to dishonour or outrage her modesty;
- denies a member of a Scheduled Caste or a Scheduled Tribe any customary right of
 passage to a place of public resort or obstructs such member so as to prevent him
 from using or having access to a place of public resort to which other members of
 public or any section thereof have a right to use or access to



Punishments

Depending upon the nature and gravity of the offence as established by the SC/ST Cell of the Institute, the possible punishments for those found guilty at the Institute level shall be any one or any combination of the following:-

- Cancellation of admission
- Suspension from attending classes
- Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits
- Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process
- Withholding results
- Debarring from representing the Institute in any regional, national or International meets, tournament, youth festival, etc.
- Suspension/expulsion from the hostel
- Rustication from the Institute for period ranging from 1 to 4 semesters
- Expulsion from the Institute and consequent debarring from admission to any other institute
